Preparing for your Resurfacing Project

Please have your space ready

1. On the day of the project, the work area must have access to hot water (at the shower head), electricity, and heat/air.
2. Any leaking faucets or drains must be repaired before the scheduled project date.
3. Before our technician arrives, clear out all items from the bathroom. This includes soaps, shampoos, trash cans, towels, plungers, countertop items, wall decorations, rugs, plants, shower curtains, and anything else in the space.
If the project is being done in the kitchen, remove all items off the countertops and within a 6-foot radius of the work area.
4. Please clean the area ahead of time by wiping down surfaces and removing dust, hair, and cobwebs. A clean environment helps ensure the best possible results.
5. We use delicate tape to attach our surface protection to surrounding areas. However, in some cases the paint or wallpaper could pull off or peel with the removal of the tape. Avoid painting walls or cabinets within two weeks of the scheduled resurfacing date. If you have already painted, you may have to touch up. If you paint afterwards, and your painter needs to tape to the surface, be sure they use delicate tape and that they are careful to protect the resurfaced areas. See our care and maintenance for more information.
6. No other work can be performed in the room during the resurfacing process.
7. Avoid any activities that create dust anywhere in the home on the day of the project.
8. Our coatings are low VOC products that meet FDA and EPA standards. To help minimize this, we use a high-powered ventilation system designed to remove airborne particles and reduce smells throughout the home. As the surface initially cures, the odor will gradually fade and can be limited to the work area by keeping the door closed. However, some individuals and pets may still be sensitive to the odor. Please plan accordingly and be prepared to leave the premises if necessary.

Important

After the project is complete, the resurfaced area must cure for 24 to 48 hours (Initial cure time). Please leave the area closed off during the initial curing time and do not let anything touch the resurfaced areas; we do not warranty against touching or using the surface during this time. Although the resurfaced areas can be put back into use after the initial cure time, the surface will require up to 30 days to completely cure. Please be gentle during this time.
