Important

After the project is complete, the resurfaced area must cure for 24 to 48 hours (Initial cure time). Please leave the area closed off during the initial curing time and do not let anything touch the resurfaced areas; we do not warranty against touching or using the surface during this time. Although the resurfaced areas can be put back into use after the initial cure time, the surface will require up to 30 days to completely cure. Please be gentle during this time.

Warranty Information

We guarantee coating adhesion for 5 years, however, with proper care and maintenance, your resurfaced area should last much longer. The warranty does not, however, cover damage caused by water leaks, dropped objects, sharp metal objects, or excessive weight bearing. Our coatings and repairs are among the strongest in the industry, however, they are not indestructible (neither is any other surface out there). Please follow the care instructions below to keep your warranty valid and continue enjoying your updated space for years to come. Please note for rental property the warranty is 3 years. Please give a copy of the care instructions to your tenants.

How to Care for your Resurfaced Area

One of the best benefits of the resurfaced area in general is that it is easy to clean. Because of the non-porous nature of the new surface, you will NOT need harsh chemicals. DO NOT USE steel wool, abrasive pads or cleaners, harsh chemicals or scrubs, acid or bleach.

- For tubs and tile, use a **mild, non-abrasive cleaner** such as diluted Dawn dish soap, Simple Green All-Purpose Cleaner, Seventh Generation Free & Clear All-Purpose Cleaner, Mrs. Meyer's Multi-Surface Cleaner, or Formula 409. Follow product directions, rinse thoroughly, and use a soft microfiber cloth for best results. We find using a microfiber cloth works great. You will love the time you'll be saving by NOT spending hours cleaning your new surface.
- For counter tops, a microfiber cloth and water are really all you need to keep the surface clean and refreshed. Please know that our coating can handle high heat, however, the surface underneath it may not. Thus, we suggest using hot pads for hot pans. Always use a cutting board as knife marks are not the fault of the coating.
- Some cleaners to **AVOID** are Dow Disinfected Cleaners, Lysol Disinfectant Cleaners, Cleaners containing ammonia, Aerosol Cleaners Tough Act, Bathroom Duck, Lest oil. Citrus-based cleaners (acidic).
- Always take care of any leaking drains and water faucets. Leaky faucets will erode the new finish causing it to crack and wear out prematurely, voiding the warranty. Do not allow water to remain sitting on the resurfaced area for extended periods of time, i.e., one week period.
- Do not lay soap bars directly on the surface or allow water, liquid or soapy residue to sit under bottles or other objects placed on the resurfaced area. Do not use suction cup mats on any resurfaced area.
- Do not forget to maintain the caulk as this is normal maintenance. Use a tub & tile, 100% waterproof caulk.
- Using acid-bearing compounds (like drain openers or grout cleaners) can damage the finish. Keep all acid-bearing chemicals—including, but not limited to cosmetics, hair dye, and perfumes—away, as they may stain or harm the surface. Damage from these products is not under warranty.

If damage accidentally incurs that is not under warranty, give us a call. We get it, no one is perfect and life happens, but we can most likely fix it! With proper care and maintenance, you will enjoy your "New Look" for years to come. Thank you for allowing us to transform your space!
